Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving net zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 68 tCO2e by 2030. This is a reduction of 20%.

Carbon reduction projects

Completed carbon reduction initiatives

This is our first year of carbon reporting. Since the reporting period, Fereday Pollard has achieved ISO 14001 certification. Our newly implemented environmental management system provides a structured framework to support the achievement of our carbon reduction objectives.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

Strengthening data collection, analysis, and reporting processes to support carbon reduction initiatives by implementing robust tracking systems, enhancing data accuracy, and enabling transparent reporting of emissions and sustainability metrics

Encouraging the adoption of sustainable transport methods among employees by promoting walking, cycling, public transport, and car-sharing options, and by investigating and potentially implementing incentive schemes such as Cycle to Work.

Enhancing the maintenance strategy for all physical assets to extend their operational lifespan, reduce downtime, and optimise lifecycle costs by implementing proactive and preventive maintenance practices, regular condition monitoring, and staff training.

Improving procurement processes to support carbon reduction by prioritising low-carbon products and services, engaging suppliers on sustainability performance, and integrating environmental criteria into purchasing decisions.

Increasing awareness and engagement around carbon reduction by delivering targeted communications, educational initiatives, and staff training that highlight the environmental impact of workplace activities and promote sustainable behaviours.
